


1. Add Redshelf to a Module in Canvas


1. Start by creating a new assignment in a module.




2. From Add Pop Down choose External Tool




3. Select RedShelf eBooks from list.



4. You now have a RedShelf link in your module.




5. When you click on the link the RedShelf Reader will launch.





2. Add Redshelf as a Menu Link using Redirect


1. Only do this process if you want a link in the Canvas Menu. This is not required if you are just using a link in the module.
First launch Redshelf from the module and copy the URL.



2. Next go to Settings and choose the Apps tab. Then find and select the Redirect Tool external app. Enter Redirect in the search field to find the app.




3. Enter the name you want for the Menu link into the Name field. Paste the URL you copied from above into the URL Redirect field.



Make sure to check the top two boxes: Force open in new tab (For external links only) Show in Course Navigation

Then click the Add App Button.

4. Click on the Navigation Tab. Check to make sure your new Menu Link appears in the enabled course navigation. (You may need to refresh the browser window)



5. The new Menu Link should appear and should launch Redshelf in Canvas.
